ADOPTION OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS

Social inclusive initiatives of the Hotel Association of India (HAI) prominently feature the plan for Adoption of National Monuments of historic importance by member-hotels. The adoption of these monuments would contribute to the enhancement of the local tourist attractions and to their preservation and maintenance for communities today and for posterity.

The HAI plan for Adoption of Monuments offers members a wide range of options. Hotels can enter into partnership either with the Indian National Trust for Art and Cultural Heritage (INTACH) or the National Culture Fund (NCF), or both, for maintenance, cleanliness, illumination, greening, landscaping etc. of any monument under their respective control.

INTACH has 35 monuments in 12 cities where HAI member hotels are located, and NCF has 18 monuments in 11 cities where HAI member hotels are located.

Hotels can donate funds ranging from Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 10 lakh or above, per monument per annum. Donations would be eligible for 100% tax benefits and the donors would be acknowledged for their contributions through Plaques, Print Collaterals and events.

HAI's Corporate Member Hotels have already been contributing to this national cause; the Oberoi Hotels, the Taj Group of Hotels and the Park Hotels have already carried out maintenance work of national monuments like the Humayun Tomb and the Jantar Mantar in New Delhi.
