Subject:- Issuance of Commercial Airport Entry Permit (AEP)-reg
Sir,

This is with reference to request submitted by your organization for issuance of Commercial Airport Entry Permit (AEP) for the inbound tour operators and hotels recognized by Ministry of Tourism. As you are aware that the matter was taken up with Ministry of Civil Aviation and after detailed deliberations, following has been granted by them vide communication no AV-13029/7/2015-AS dated 01.06.2020-:

1. Two commercial AEPs may be issued to inbound tour operators having annual turnover of up to Rs. 20 Crore.
2. Four commercial AEPs may be issued to inbound tour operators having annual turnover of up to Rs. 20 Crore to Rs. 50 Crore.
3. Eight commercial AEPs may be issued to inbound tour operators having annual turnover more than Rs. 50 Crore.
4. Two commercial AEPs may be issued to 4 Star hotels and four commercial AEPs to 5 Star and 5 Star deluxe hotels.

You are requested to inform your members recognized by Ministry of Tourism for the aforesaid.
