World Hand Hygiene Day @ The Oberoi Amarvilas

World Hand Hygiene Day was celebrated by The Oberoi Amarvilas on 5th May 2015 as per the guidelines of Hotel Association of India. The Main aim of celebrating the event was to create an environment in hotel and public areas conducive to the hand hygiene day's significance.

The Day started with demonstrations of hand washing for school students of Lopa Mudra Vidya Mandir Purva Madhyamik Vidhyalaya, Taj Ganj, Agra on how and when to properly wash hands. Chef Vaibhav Soni told the students about the importance of hand hygiene and 10 steps of washing their hands; this was followed by a demonstration of hand washing in which students enthusiastically participated.

General Manager Mr Ankush Mahajan and team gave away soap packs to the children to take home, share their knowledge of hand hygiene with their families and spread awareness about its benefits.













After the visit to school The Oberoi Amarvilas team participated in Poster Making Competition to spread awareness with the help of colors to promote the theme of hand hygiene and encourage all to make it part of their plans to mark World Hand Hygiene Day. In which team members participated with enthusiasm and expressed their knowledge about hand hygiene with colors, first prize was won by the poster made by Shruti, Akrati, Ishwar and Sushobhit which had the message "Germs are not for Sharing, scrub them off"





Later a Presentation on hand hygiene was given by the Kitchen team with a video on how to correctly wash hands , followed by a demonstration of hand washing.

Hand washing isn't exactly an arduous chore, especially since it's done in the name of killing germs, says Sous Chef Hasan Mehndi Rizvi while explaining the methods and importance of Hand Hygiene to the team members.





Short films were screened on television in public area and Framed Posters promoting Hand Hygiene Day has been put in public areas, staff cafeteria, staff rest rooms where they are visible to the team while they are washing their hands.





People need to wash their hands for about 15 to 20 seconds to kill any type of dangerous bacteria. Most people wash their hands for about six seconds. Without executing the correct hand sanitizing techniques, grime, dirt and bacteria that would otherwise be sent down the drain stays on the hands and increases the host's likelihood of becoming seriously ill. Washing hands properly after using the toilet, handling animals and before and after handling food helps prevent the spread of various forms of germs, some of which can cause serious health problems.





<u>Videos</u>: Short videos on 'Steps of washing hands technique' were played during tea / lunch breaks.






<u>Session on Hand Hygiene and Hand Washing Technique for Hunar Se Rozgar</u> <u>Candidates</u>
