To make the associates and guests abreast about the importance of Hand Hygiene and to create substantial awareness, we conducted the following activities:


- Screened a short film on the importance of hand hygiene in the employee cafeteria

The Suryaa conducted the following activities:


- Displayed posters with awareness messages




